# Video clip request form

This resource corresponds to **Chapter 18: Using video clips in the classroom.**

## Content

This is a template that can be given to any student requesting that you show a specific clip in class. Among other things, it asks them to describe the clip, explain why they think it would be good for class and to prepare some questions for their classmates.

## Rationale

I find the video clip request form useful because:

- ▶ student petitions for clips can sometimes be distracting or overwhelming
- ▶ it helps students see that a clip in English class has to fulfill various functions, not just be entertaining
- ▶ it invites the student suggesting the clip to engage with its content more fully
- ▶ it may serve as a lead in to a lesson phase where that student has an increased role, taking ownership and responsibility for overseeing the comprehension questions they have put together.
