

Bean haunted house template

Content

A template for your learners to stick their monster beans to and decorate

Rationale

You will find a detailed explanation of how to set up the bean activity in **Lesson commentary for providing support** on pages 313–317. You will also be able to read about how to support the learners in terms of familiarising them with some of the language and providing what is basically a drawing tutorial for the bean items (zombie, pumpkin, ghost, etc.). Once they have completed their beans, they can be given the template.

The template itself contains various additional prompts, instructing learners to draw smoke coming from the chimney, a secret door in the tree and a tunnel under the house. If you think these prompts will confuse them, you can delete them or adapt them so they are more suitable for your particular learners. Similarly, you might want to adapt the template itself to include additional features, or to prompt your learners with more ideas as they are working. For example, there could be a ladder going from one floor of the house to the next, or up into the attic. There could be ivy growing up the walls of the house. The tree itself could have eyes or there could be a swing or a bird cage hanging from its branches.
