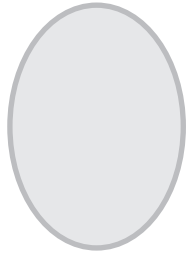

Rationale

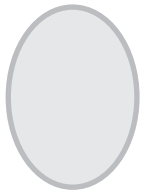
This worksheet is designed for younger learners who may not be writing independently quite yet. There is a detailed description of how to set up the activity in **Working with imported materials and objects** on pages 131–135, in terms of distributing materials, so the reader is recommended to read through that first. Prior to this, you may also wish to run through a demonstration of the activity with your students or have an example already prepared to inspire them.

The worksheet itself has grey lettering to give your students the chance to overwrite the words. In addition, they may want to draw faces on the grey ovals next to these words. The house below is large enough for them to include an upstairs and a downstairs but not so large that their bean family gets lost in it!
